

# 2019 MUNICIPAL PRIMARY UMOVA NOTICE

## Instructions

- You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB).
- You may use the FWAB to vote for candidates for **all** state and local offices, and ballot initiatives.
- To vote, refer to page 3 of the FWAB.
  - To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives – write the names of candidates or the ballot initiative in the Addendum Section of the FWAB
    - Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum).
    - Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum questions write “yes” or “no.”

This is an official notice of an election to be conducted on 5/21/2019 in Montour County. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at [www.votespa.com](http://www.votespa.com) or [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov). You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (570 ) 271 -3088, or by email to [ddyer@montourco.org](mailto:ddyer@montourco.org).

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for **all** state and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum questions write "yes" or "no."

WARRIOR RUN SCHOOL DIRECTOR – Vote for Not More Than Two – Anthony and Limestone Townships

MAYOR – Vote for One – Washingtonville Borough

TAX COLLECTOR – 2 yr. term – Vote for One – Cooper and Mahoning Townships, Danville and Washingtonville Boroughs

SUPERVISOR –6 yr. term - Vote for One – All Precincts except Danville and Washingtonville Boroughs

COUNCILMAN –4 yr. term - Vote for One (each Ward) – Danville Borough

COUNCILMAN –4 yr. term - Vote for Two – Washingtonville Borough

COUNCILMAN – 2 yr. term – Vote for One – Washingtonville Borough

AUDITOR – 6 yr. term – Vote for One – All Precincts except Danville Borough

AUDITOR – 4 yr. term. – Vote for One –Liberty, Mayberry and Washingtonville

AUDITOR – 2 yr. term – Vote for One –Liberty and Washingtonville
